Kindergarten

Artists finished creating winter wonderlands by using oil pastels and watercolor resist techniques. Next artists will begin exploring clay and different ways we can use clay to create 3D sculptures.

1st Grade

Artists continued to work on their collaborative murals of animals in their habitats. Next artists will create word art using words from their animal habitats using oil pastels to create a frame for their mural.

2nd Grade

Artists finished creating their paintings of New York City using tempera paint and multiple paint brushes. Next artists will create clay pots using coiling, slipping and scoring techniques.

3rd Grade

Artists began working on artwork inspired by their ultimate silly sandwich. 3rd graders will use color pencil techniques and mixed media materials to create visual texture in their artwork.

4th Grade

Artists will continue exploring color value with their landscape paintings. Next artists will move into their clay unit where they will learn about pinch pots as well as coiling, slipping and scoring to create animal/creature pots.

Artists wrapped up their extensive self portrait unit and are excited to move into their clay unit in the New Year! Artists will create fake food vessels using multiple clay techniques including slipping and scoring.
