We Will Learn...

Reading & Writing

Over the next three weeks, third graders will build their knowledge about plays, with a focus on the drama genre. We will read texts and view videos about the features of classic and contemporary plays. Children will also write an opinion essay about whether or not the stories in this module worked well as plays.

Math

Topic 4 focuses on learning division facts by using the relationship between multiplication and division. Your child will learn that related multiplication facts can be used to help with division facts. In this topic, your child will use the inverse relationship of multiplication and division to generate fact families and learn division facts. The rules for dividing by 1 comes from the Identity Property of Multiplication. Your child will explore division with O in this topic. Division must be carefully considered when O is involved. Your child will use multiplication and division to explain patterns associated with even and odd numbers. In this topic, your child will solve and write division problems.
